NVQ in Children's Care, Learning & Development Level 2

This is a flexible work-based qualification that is nationally recognised. It is aimed at people who work with children and young people aged 0–16. It is relevant to people working in day care, crèches, preschools and schools, hospitals, primary care and community-based services such as SureStart programmes.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week in a childcare setting.
- Must have a contract of employment.

Funding Eligibility

We could fund or part-fund the qualification if you:

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.

Mandatory Units

- Contribute to positive relationships
- Help to keep children safe
- Support children's development
- Use support to develop own practice in children's care, learning and development
- Prepare and maintain environments to meet children's needs
- Support children's play and learning

Optional Units

Will be decided by you and your assessor to identify the most appropriate units for your role and setting.

Duration / Assessment

- 6-8 months
- One-to-one assessments in the workplace
- Produce a portfolio of evidence with assessor

It is relevant to people working in day care, crèches, preschools and schools, hospitals, primary care and community-based services such as SureStart programmes. It is also relevant to people working as childminders.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week in a supervisory role within a childcare setting.
- Must have a contract of employment.

Funding Eligibility

We could fund or part-fund the qualification if you:

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.
