As well as relating directly to the role of teaching assistant it also includes roles and responsibilities such as cover supervision, pastoral support, bilingual support, subject support and special educational needs.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week in a role supporting learning in an educational setting.
- Must have a contract of employment.

Funding Eligibility

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.

Will be decided by you and your assessor to identify the most appropriate units for your role and setting.

Duration / Assessment

- 6–8 months
- One-to-one assessments in the workplace
- Produce a portfolio of evidence with assessor

They may also have limited responsibility for directing the work of others.

As well as relating directly to the role of teaching assistant it also includes roles and responsibilities such as cover supervision, pastoral support, bilingual support, subject support and special educational needs.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week in a supervisory role supporting learning in an educational setting.
- Must have a contract of employment.

Funding Eligibility

We could fund or part-fund the qualification if you:

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.
