

NVQ in Health & Social Care Level 2

This is a flexible work-based qualification that is nationally recognised. It is about direct care, where the focus is hands-on care and supporting and enabling clients/service users to do things for themselves. Candidates will usually be delivering care in support of (and under the direction of) a colleague who is accountable in the area of practise.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week in a health and social care setting.
- Must have a contract of employment.

Funding Eligibility

We could fund or part-fund the qualification if you:

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.

Units / Topics Covered

6 units must be completed:

2 core units, 2 optional units plus 2 units from either the core or optional groups.

Core Units

- Communicate with and complete records for individuals
- Support the health and safety of yourself and individuals
- Develop your knowledge and practice
- Ensure your own actions support the care, protection and well-being of individuals

Optional Units

Will be decided by you and your assessor to identify the most appropriate units for your role and setting.

Duration / Assessment

- 4–6 months
- One-to-one assessments in your workplace
- Produce a portfolio of evidence with assessor

NVQ in Health & Social Care (Adults) Level 3

This is a flexible work-based qualification that is nationally recognised. It is about the delivery of physical, emotional or enabling care to clients/service users. Candidates may often be working without direct supervision or on their own. Candidates will have a degree of responsibility and autonomy, and will be required to make decisions.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week in a supervisory role within a health and social care setting.
- Must have a contract of employment.

Funding Eligibility

We could fund or part-fund the qualification if you:

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.

4 core units plus 4 optional units.

Core Units

- Promote effective communication for and about individuals
- Promote, monitor and maintain health, safety and security in the working environment
- Reflect on and develop your practice
- Promote choice, well-being and the protection of all individuals

Optional Units

Will be decided by you and your assessor to identify the most appropriate units for your role and setting.

Duration / Assessment

- 6–12 months
- One-to-one assessments in your workplace
- Produce a portfolio of evidence with assessor
