NVQ in Warehousing & Storage Level 2

This is a flexible work-based qualification that is nationally recognised. It is about the safe and efficient receipt, movement, storage, handling and dispatch of goods in a warehousing and logistics environment. Candidates should have a degree of autonomy and be required to make decisions within agreed boundaries and limits.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week in a role undertaking warehousing, storage and logistics activities.
- Must have a contract of employment.

Funding Eligibility

We could fund or part-fund the qualification if you:

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.

Units / Topics Covered

8 units must be completed:
2 mandatory units and 6 optional units.

Mandatory Units

- Maintain health, safety and security in logistics operations
- Develop effective working relationships with colleagues in logistics operations

Optional Units

Will be decided by you and your assessor to identify the most appropriate units for your role and setting.

Duration / Assessment

- 6–8 months
- One-to-one assessments in the workplace
- Produce a portfolio of evidence with assessor

NVQ in Plant Operations Level 2

This is a flexible work-based qualification that is nationally recognised. It is suitable for candidates who operate one of the wide variety of fork lift trucks used to lift, transfer and position loads. The candidate will be operating fork lift trucks under supervision as part of a team. The NVQ includes the RTITB (Road Traffic Industry Training Board) Fork Lift Truck Training and Test.

Entry Requirements

- Must be working for at least 16 hours per week.
- Must have a contract of employment.
- Please note any person that has a criminal conviction for either commercial break-in or commercial robbery are prohibited from training on a fork lift truck. They can still complete the rest of the qualification.

Funding Eligibility

We could fund or part-fund the qualification if you:

- are over 19 years old and
- have lived in the UK for 3 years or more, come from an EU member country or are a British Citizen.

Units / Topics Covered

4 mandatory units must be completed.
There are also 2 additional units.

Mandatory Units

- Conform to general workplace safety
- Conform to efficient work practices
- Prepare plant or machinery for operational performance
- Operate plant or machinery to lift and transfer loads

Additional Units

- Move and handle resources
- Slings and signalling the movement of loads

These units are available to test your broader skills as an operator but are not required for the full NVQ.

Duration / Assessment

- 3–4 months
- One-to-one assessments in the workplace
- Produce a portfolio of evidence with assessor
- The RTITB Fork Lift Truck Test consists of a 35 minute practical test and a 25 minute theory test

- Plant Operator/Fork Lift Truck Operator
- Picker/Packer
